

BIC “DRAG AND DRIFT NIGHTS” TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Cars

- (a) All cars must be fitted with functioning seatbelts
- (b) All cars must be fitted with a full exhaust system. No open or straight thru pipes.
- (c) No loose bodywork. IE Bumpers/Body kits etc.
- (d) All cars must have a fully functioning braking system capable of locking all 4 wheels when tested
- (e) It is advisable that all cars are fitted with a hand held fire extinguisher inside the cockpit

Drivers/ Passengers

- (a) Drivers must hold a full Road license
- (b) Seatbelts are to be worn at all times during Drifting
- (c) No Sandals or open type shoes to be worn
- (d) No Shorts to be worn, legs must be fully covered
- (e) Passengers must be a minimum of 16 yrs. of age

The Course

- (a) Drivers may run 2 laps of the predetermined course per session.
- (b) The number of sessions per driver is unlimited, but is dependent on the amount of drivers taking part in the event that night.
- (c) All cones knocked over/moved during a drivers session must be replaced by that driver before he leaves the course

Note: Any driver found to be ignoring the rules or driving dangerously will be removed from the event and possibly banned from future Drifting events.
